This is a very rough user's manual for MakeFan, it will eventually be replaced with something a bit more polished. MakeFan draws "fans", which are radial guidelines with equal angular spacing on images (tiff, jpeg or bitmap) of specimens to aid in digitizing points along curves or contours. This approach is intended to be used in conjunction with semi-landmark methods, utilizing the SemiLand6 program. Obtain a copy of SemiLand6 if you haven't already, and read the files *SemiLand6_manual* and *Semi-Land_becki* included with it as well.

The first section of this manual is the pdf form of a PowerPoint presentation on MakeFan I wrote for a workshop on morphometrics at Berkeley in June 2002. The comment about the Red Wings is a joke about Miriam, ask her what it means when you meet her....

Following the Power Point derived material, is a short set of instructions on how to run MakeFan.
